



Rwanda – Available from July 2007



Day 1 : Depart UK

Fly with Kenya Airlines from London Heathrow to Nairobi (2000/0630*) in economy class. Transfer to the Kigali flight (0800/1035) * denotes arrival the next day

Day 2 – 5 : Sabyinyo Silverback Lodge

On arrival at Kigali Airport you will met and transferred to Sabyinyo Silverback Lodge which lies at the foot of the impressive Sabyinyo Volcano, adjacent to the Parc des Volcanes.



Opening in July 2007, the Sabyinyo Silverback Lodge is the latest property in the portfolio to be managed by Kenya's award-winning luxury safari operator, Governors' Camp and will provide some of the most exclusive and luxurious Gorilla tracking accommodation in Rwanda.

Nearly half the world's wild Mountain Gorilla population lives on the slopes of the Virunga Volcano range; and guests will experience the rare privilege of trekking amongst the misty, forested volcanoes visiting one of five habituated families, for a rewarding close-up of these amazing creatures.



You can also trek into the mountains to see other wildlife in the forest which includes a troupe of habituated golden monkeys, which dwell in the bamboo forests, on the lower slopes. They won't allow you to get as close as you would to the gorillas, but it makes for an interesting walk.

Sabyinyo Silverback Lodge is an intimate 16-bed property which has been built by Governors' Camp in conjunction with local Gorilla conservation programmes. The Kinigi community, which owns the land where the lodge was built, will directly benefit from the tourism this lodge will provide, thus providing more incentive to protect gorillas and other wildlife.

Early morning arrival at Heathrow.
